Brief summary of the content of the workshop	The workshop focused on issues concerning work - related L2 development and reviewed the products developed throughout the project (2016-2018). All participants shared ideas of the conditions and data of 31 European countries in the field of second language learning by immigrants, being employed in foreign countries, getting to learn the second language.
What did you find particularly useful?	The workshop gave the unique experience to representatives of different European countries to gather and discuss the latest news concerning the learning a foreign language as second by immigrants who live away from their country. I deepened knowledge as an adults' educator and philologist, got ideas for the teaching procedure, the parameters that intervene in getting to learn a foreign language and the conditions that have to take in mind when working with foreigners.
